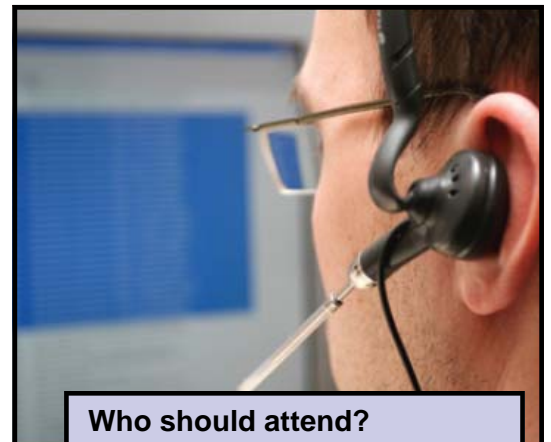
# Wireless 9-1-1 Training Workshop

Areas within Kansas may experience as many as 75 percent of their 9-1-1 calls from wireless devices. While these devices are widely used they create distinct challenges for public safety, both in deployment and management of the service.

The Kansas Association of Counties (KAC) and League of Kansas Municipalities (LKM) are sponsoring a complimentary Wireless 9-1-1 training workshop. This workshop will address the major components and challenges of wireless 9-1-1 and provide the necessary information and tools to manage this challenge.
