## Message from the Chief

The Kansas Coordinating Council shared the "Kansas NG9-1-1 Story" at the APCO International Emerging Technology Forum. With 300 people in attendance from across the nation, Chief Dick Heitschmidt (above) and Jay Coverdale (left) addressed all aspects of our NG9-1-1 system.

The presentation was received so well that a number of representatives in the public sector are reaching to us asking lots of questions such as:

• How is Kansas NG9-1-1 so successful?

- How long did it take to begin migrating PSAPs?
- What suggestions do you have for our own state?
