Dear Telecommunication Provider,

On July 1, 2019, House Bill 2084 will go into effect. House Bill 2084 amends the Kansas 911 Act and includes changes to the existing 911 fees currently collected and remitted by Telecommunication Providers. The law imposes a 911 fee per month, per subscriber account of any exchange telecommunications service, wireless telecommunications service, voice over Internet protocol service, or other service capable of contacting a Public Safety Answering Point. The bill increases the 911 fee from \$0.60 to \$0.90 per month, per subscriber account. The law requires service providers to collect the 911 fees and remit such fees to the Local Collection Point Administrator (LCPA) for distribution to the Public Safety Answering Points pursuant to the Act.

Telecommunication Providers are to begin collecting the \$0.90 fee on July 1, 2019 and remit these fees to the LCPA in August 2019.
