Bankruptcy Filings by Service Providers

Recently a PSAP was notified of a bankruptcy filing by a service provider. This brought up the question of how bankruptcy filings and claims for unpaid 911 fee funds would be handled. The LCPA has stated that on any such filings, where the unpaid fees were a significant amount, the LCPA would file the proof of claim in an attempt to recover these unpaid 911 fees. The LCPA would disburse any recovered monies to the affected PSAPs. This will alleviate the individual PSAPs from having to file proof of claims.
