- PSA Contest Update
 - It is clear several PSAPs shared the PSA contest information with their local schools as Melanie has heard from several schools inquiring about the contest. Some schools advised they could not get it in to their curriculum until the second semester to be ready by Spring Break.
 - The Committee decided to extend the deadline to March 20, 2020 in order to give schools more time. This would give the Subcommittee 2 weeks to review the entries and have the top 3 presented at April's Full Council meeting for a vote.
 - New Letters will be drafted and sent to the Kansas Department of Schools & the Kansas Association of School Boards with and update. Lori requested to share this on social media as well so more PSAPs would let their area high schools know of the new deadline.
 - Subcommittee will review all submissions the last 2 weeks of March to have them readied for a Full Council vote in April.
- Policy Recommendation & Best Practice review timeline
 - December Subcommittee reviews current policy/best practice recommendations
 - These will be sent out via email on a word document
 - January Rapid Deploy Radius Plus training begins via webinar approximately 30 minutes, week of Jan. 22nd. As many Text Subcommittee members should attend this training to begin tweaking policy/best practice recommendations or gather input from those in your PSAPs on their ideas. Gathering input from the front line users should be done.
 - February Subcommittee members send any updates to policy/best practices to Melanie Bergers. This will be updated on a shared drive for the committee to review and have a final document presented to the Full Council in April for approval and publishing.
 - Goal is for the Policy recommendations to be approved and published by the full council in May.

Updates and timelines will be sent out after each meeting via e-mail so that the Committee can stay engaged and offer assistance with keeping us moving forward via e-mail.
