Meeting: Annual KS 911 Security Committee Meeting

KS 911 Security Committee met in person and on line to discuss the KS Hosted 911 system network as it relates to cyber security.

-Great dialogue between Security team to determine what would be the best steps for the KS Hosted 911 program. Discussion concluded that there is no specific standards set that are universally applicable to the KS Hosted 911 program. General thought is to combine programs and customize the type of audit that best suits the KS program.

1-Last audit was provided 12/2017, so will delay decision on next audit and discuss in next security meeting in 2020

2- Team preferred the idea of having this committee review SAFECOM guidance in regard to establishing risk levels of the system to develop our security standards.

Once more information is gained, we will utilize that guidance to establish risk levels of the system and identify NIST SP 800-53 controls to address the identified risks at such point the committee will get back together as a group to go thru these items. The next meeting will be a face to face meeting.

3-Team concluded; that a system Penetration test would be valuable and would proceed down that path. Another call will be held at a later date to discuss the details of this test.
